Pest Control Experts Provide the Safest Bed Bug Treatments In The U.S.

In a town in Northern Thailand, a tourist's death is being blamed on the overzealous pesticide spraying for bed bugs. Reports are that the 23 year old woman from New Zealand was vacationing at a resort in Chiang Mai when she suddenly became ill and subsequently died from pesticide exposure.

A consultant to the United Nations, who specializes in hazardous chemicals, has traveled to the hotel in question and has taken swab samples of the woman's room. A chemical called "Chlorpyrifos", which is banned for indoor use in most countries, was found present in the hotel room. It should be noted that the day prior to the woman dying, the guest in the adjoining room fell ill with the same symptoms and also died. Additionally, the resort in question promptly closed down after the deaths of the guests and reportedly underwent an extensive cleaning process. Despite the extensive cleaning, nearly three months after the deaths, the pesticide was still detectable by the United Nations consultant, which is a clear indication of a high level of insecticide present on the scene months before. In total, there have been seven tourists, one of which is from America, who has fallen victim to the same symptoms, illness, and eventual death in the resort town.

EPA complaints may continue to rise along with the increase of bed bug infestations throughout the United States. At least US citizens can be assured of the safety of the bed bug pesticides that are currently available.
